There are always interesting speakers and informative workshops. Our first workshop was on the tax consequences of EBRWF being what the IRS calls a 527 Political Organization. Fortunately or unfortunately, we do not meet the criteria (gross receipts of \$25,000 per year) for our club to have any tax consequences or even have to do any filing with the IRS.
